Responsibility	Positive Choice	Negative Choice
Engage in your learning and try your best	Students listen with intent, pose questions and give each task a go every time. Attends class on time every lesson and is prepared for lessons. Complete the task and return promptly.	Students are unable to follow reasonable teacher instructions or engage in learning activities. Does not complete work when asked to or is consistently off task. Does not attend class on time, leaves class without permission or does not attend classes.
Work together and allow others to speak and be heard	Students assist other students when they notice they need help. Listen to other students in their group and share their own ideas with others. Wait for their turn to speak.	Students are unable to work with others on the task without distracting or displaying inappropriate behaviour towards others. Students refuse to work with others when asked and do not communicate politely with peers.
Respect other people's feelings, identity and property	Students think first before speaking and speak positively towards others and keep negative comments to themselves. Ask before using someone else's property and use their belongings respectfully.	Students make prejudiced comments towards others. Steals or damages personal property. Makes negative and hurtful comments about a student's appearance, interests or community.
Deal with concerns calmly and respectfully	Students are able to stop, think and report a concern to a trusted adult. Walk away to avoid conflict. Speaks calmly and listens to other people's opinions without getting upset.	Students threaten others with violence, perpetuates violence, or makes rude or inappropriate comments towards other people.
Report incidents to a trusted adult	Students have the confidence to speak up and let the teacher know when they need support. Willing to complete a referral to the Wellbeing Hub.	Students do not report possible concerning behaviour to a teacher. Attempts to solve serious concern without support of a trusted adult.
Use electronic devices for learning purposes only	Student laptop is charged and used when asked to by the teacher. Students regularly check emails for communication, access their Google Classroom to receive and submit work. Mobile Phones are in their bags and in lockers (Middle School) and on silent or turned off.	Students use their school device inappropriately through playing games, social conversations and accessing inappropriate material. Students access their personal devices in class without permission.
Wear school uniform with pride and respect our school environment	Students are always in the correct uniform. They keep their desk space clean and tidy. Always disposes of rubbish appropriately. Picks up rubbish and places it in the bin.	Students wear Inappropriate uniforms without acceptable reason and/or refuse to change when asked to. Students steal, damage or vandalise school property and/or does not keep public areas clean.
