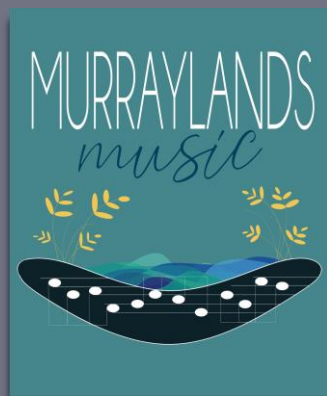
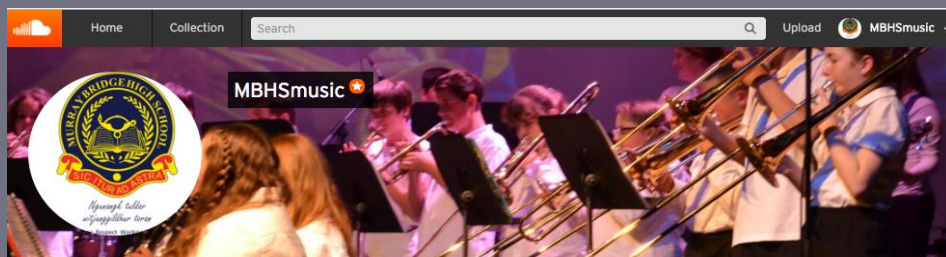

This course offers students the opportunity to pursue their interests in music through performance, creating and music technology as a full year subject. Students can complete an **Expression of Interest** if they meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Has a high level of motivation and passion for music
- Is currently having instrumental lessons
- Has sung in the Festival of Music Choir
- Has been involved with community performing arts groups/productions.

Students enrolled in this course will be required to have instrumental tuition on their chosen instrument, and in some cases students may also wish to take up a second instrument. There will be opportunities to perform at different events and take part in special music workshops with guest artists and conductors.
